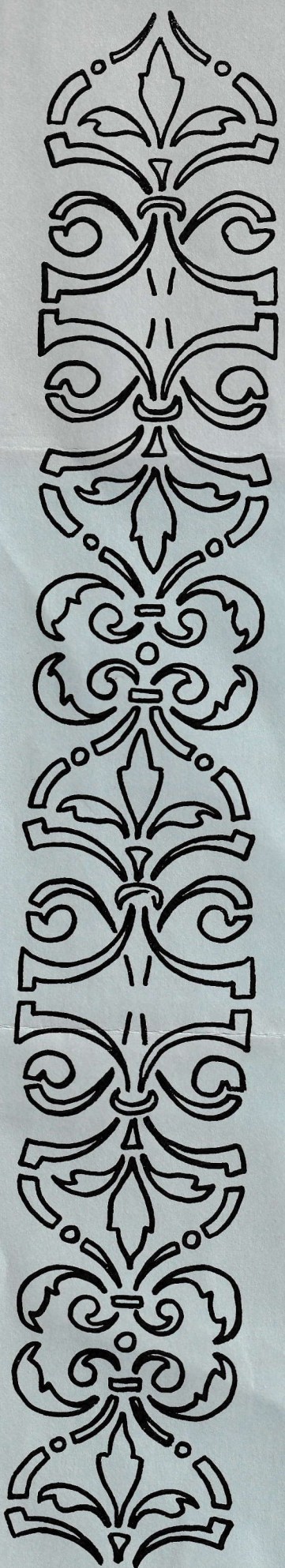

The Compton Heights Concert Band of St. Louis was organized in 1976. Initially, the Band performed at Compton Heights Neighborhood events such as the Easter, July 4th and Christmas celebrations. The Band's membership numbered 18 at its first performance. Growing rapidly in size and experience, the Band made its first major public appearance in August, 1977, in the Tower Grove Park Concert Series held in the Shaw Memorial Bandstand. Presently, the Band consists of sixty members who represent some of the leading amateur, student and professional musicians from the St. Louis Metropolitan Area. The Band continues to be St. Louis' only community concert band and includes in its membership lawyers, doctors, teachers, journalists, nurses, retailers, small business owners, printers, government workers, computer specialists, a judge and other miscellaneous occupations.
