THE COMPTON HEIGHTS CONCERT BAND

Whether it's an antique clock or a stately old house, perhaps you have felt the sense of satisfaction that comes from restoring and breathing life into some relic of a bygone day. That same preservationist philosophy is the driving force behind the Compton Heights Concert Band of St. Louis and our efforts to promote and perform the fine concert band literature of yesteryear.

The band was organized in 1976 by Band President, Harry Swanger, who formed the band to provide music for Compton Heights neighborhood events. Now numbering over 60 volunteer, student and professional musicians, the band annually presents 30 concerts in St. Louis and outstate Missouri.

Musical Mondays, the band's eight week summer series presented annually since 1980, is held in Tower Grove Park. The band's other popular series, *Sunday Serenades*, held in Francis Park in south St. Louis, began in 1986. These musical traditions attract 50,000 listeners annually. This year the Band inaugurates a third series, a four part *Tune-Full Tuesdays* series in Jefferson Barracks Park, South County, in the Amphitheater.

Featuring a Sousa-style program, each concert includes outstanding soloists. Some of the nation's most talented musicians have appeared, including William Warfield, Debbye Turner, The Nuclear Whales Saxophone Orchestra, Sukay, Robert Ellison, Ricardo Morales, and Arturo Sandoval. Under the Missouri Arts Council touring program, the band has been acclaimed by audiences in Hermann, Joplin, Farmington, St. Joseph, St. Peters, Jefferson City, and Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

Gregory Fox was appointed Conductor of the band in September 1992. Greg calls the opportunity to present 30 concerts a year "unique" and finds the audiences "the greatest!" Greg holds the Doctor of Education in Music Education from the University of Illinois at Champaign-Urbana, studying conducting under the noted Harry Begian.

The announcer for our concerts is Lucille Schroeder, wife of band vice-president and tubist Jon Schroeder. In addition to her pleasant voice and professional demeanor, Lucy injects a lively sense of humor and energy into every concert, and helps the audience gain a deeper understanding and appreciation of the music the band is presenting.

The band is funded by individual and corporate donations, weekly Friday night and Saturday daytime charity Bingos at Bandwagon Hall, 6245 Lemay Ferry Road at Baumgartner, the Missouri Arts Council, the Regional Arts Commission, the Metro South Arts Council, the Clifford Willard Gaylord Foundation, and the Monsanto Fund.

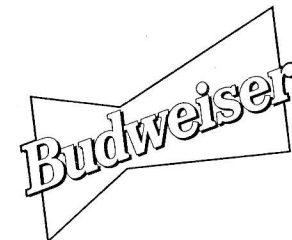

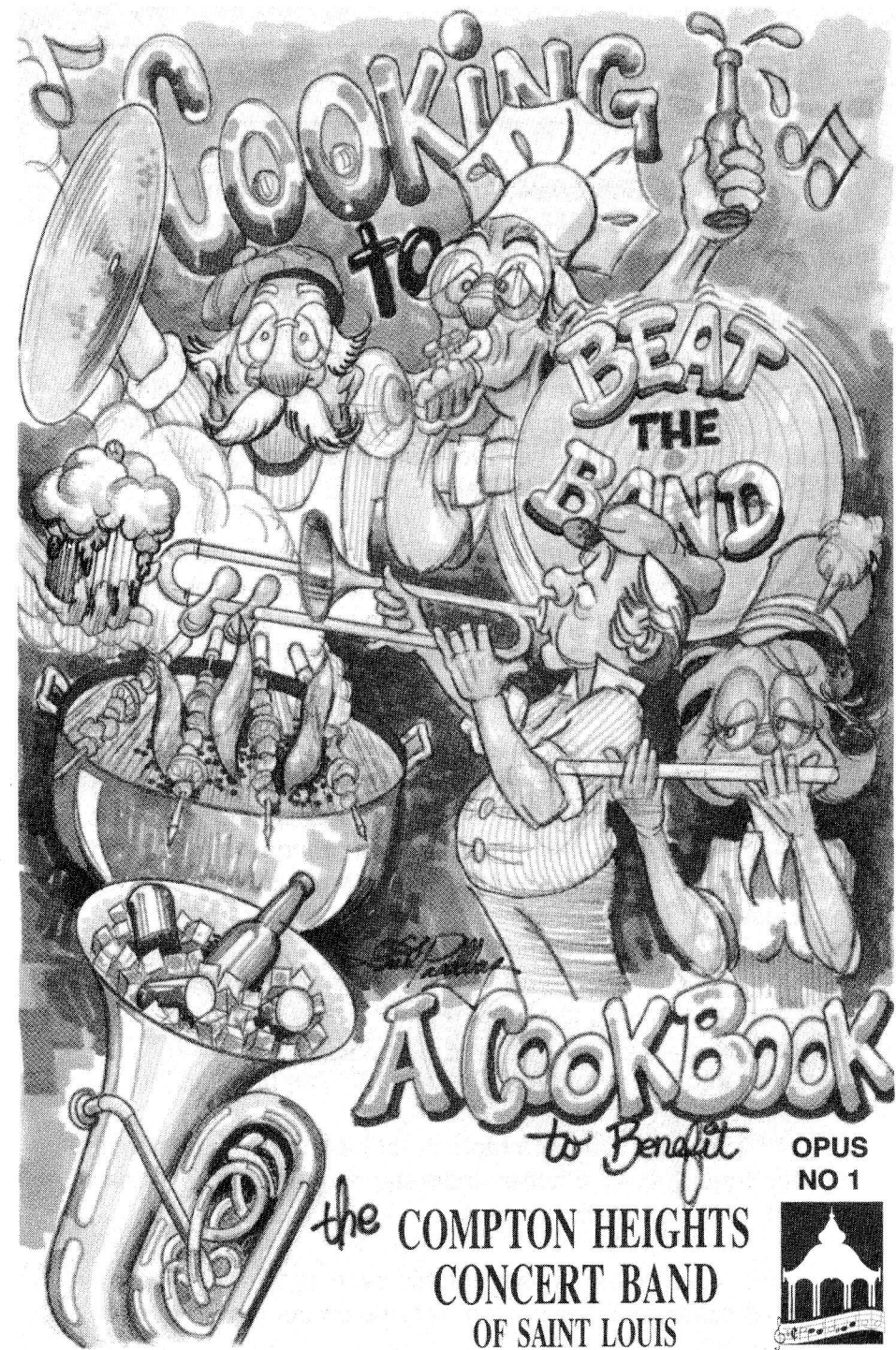
For years, Scottsdale, Arizona composer/arranger J. Durward Morsch has been acquiring original scores from the copyright holders and obtaining their permission to transcribe these orchestral scores for concert band. His goal has been to transcribe these scores directly for the concert band, thereby keeping them as close to the original as possible. His efforts so far have produced 300 transcriptions, including over 100 film scores. These transcriptions from movie scores include suites from Batman, Silverado, The Rocketeer and many of the old swashbucklers from the 1940's and 50's.

Morsch's work goes a long way in dispelling the common perception that those who compose for the films are seemingly less skilled and serious than those who write for smaller audiences. Famed movie composer, Jerry Goldsmith has eloquently addressed this notion:

"I compose music for films, which makes me a film composer. Which is fine except that the tag "film composer" in this country has come to have a kind of second-class ring to it. This is ridiculous. People have never tagged Paul Hindemith or Arnold Schoenberg as "professor composers" with the implication that it was a lesser rank. Some men who write music earn a living by teaching. Still others, like me, make our way by working films. We are all composers. I tackle every assignment just as seriously as if I were aiming it at the concert hall." (Jerry Goldsmith in Tony Thomas, ed., Film Score, the View from the Podium; South Brunswick and New York: A.S. Barnes and Company, 1979.)

We thank J. Durward Morsch for his monumental contributions in furtherance of a better understanding and appreciation of the work of film score composers.

For your further enjoyment this evening we will coordinate the movie scores and the motion pictures on our new projection screen system.

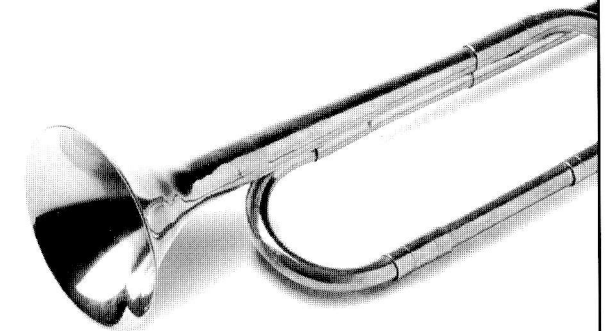
