## THE COMPTON HEIGHTS CONCERT BAND

Whether it's an antique clock or a stately old house, perhaps you have felt the sense of satisfaction that comes from restoring and breathing life into some relic of a bygone day. That same preservationist philosophy is the driving force behind the Compton Heights Concert Band of St. Louis and our efforts to promote and perform the fine concert band literature of yesteryear.

The band was organized in 1976 by Band President, Harry Swanger, who formed the band to provide music for Compton Heights neighborhood events. Now numbering over 60 volunteer, student and professional musicians, the band annually presents 30 concerts in St. Louis and outstate Missouri.

*Musical Mondays*, the band's eight week summer series presented annually since 1980, is held in Tower Grove Park. The band's other popular series, *Sunday Serenades*, held in Francis Park in south St. Louis, began in 1986. These musical traditions attract 50,000 listeners annually. This year the Band inaugurates a third series, a four part *Tune-Full Tuesdays* series in Jefferson Barracks Park, South County, in the Amphitheater.

Featuring a Sousa-style program, each concert includes outstanding soloists. Some of the nation's most talented musicians have appeared, including William Warfield, Debbye Turner, The Nuclear Whales Saxophone Orchestra, Sukay, Robert Ellison, Ricardo Morales, and Arturo Sandoval. Under the Missouri Arts Council touring program, the band has been acclaimed by audiences in Hermann, Joplin, Farmington, St. Joseph, St. Peters, Jefferson City, and Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

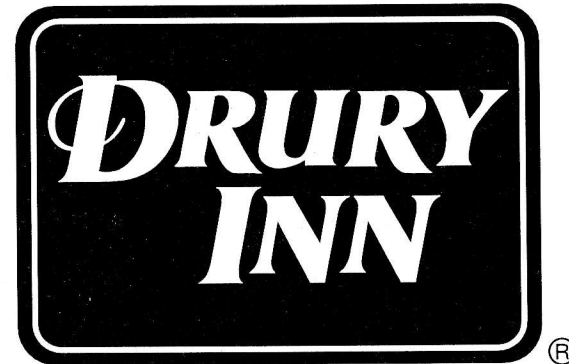
Gregory Fox was appointed Conductor of the band in September 1992. Greg calls the opportunity to present 30 concerts a year "unique" and finds the audiences "the greatest!" Greg holds the Doctor of Education in Music Education from the University of Illinois at Champaign-Urbana, studying conducting under the noted Harry Begian.

The announcer for our concerts is Lucille Schroeder, wife of band vice-president and tubist Jon Schroeder. In addition to her pleasant voice and professional demeanor, Lucy injects a lively sense of humor and energy into every concert, and helps the audience gain a deeper understanding and appreciation of the music the band is presenting.

The band is funded by individual and corporate donations, weekly Friday night and Saturday daytime charity Bingos at Bandwagon Hall, 6245 Lemay Ferry Road at Baumgartner, the Missouri Arts Council, the Regional Arts Commission, the Metro South Arts Council, the Clifford Willard Gaylord Foundation, and the Monsanto Fund.

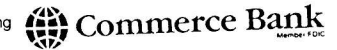

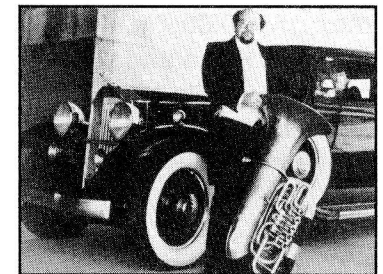
# B a c k s t a g e Bio

**Jan Gippo**, piccoloist, has appeared fourteen times as soloist with the Compton Heights Concert Band. The St. Louis Symphony piccolo player since 1972, Gippo currently serves on several local, college faculties. Gippo holds a Bachelors in Applied Flute and a Masters in Applied Flute and Wind Ensemble Conducting Literature, both from the New England Conservatory of Music. Gippo collects/publishes piccolo solo works from around the world and lectures frequently on the subject of piccolo playing.



**Steve Seward**, tuba soloist, started his musical training on the trumpet at the age of eight, switching to tuba as a junior high school student. He holds a Bachelor of Music Degree in tuba performance from the University of Michigan. His teacher was the eminent, former principal tuba of the Philadelphia Orchestra, Abe Torchinsky. At the University of Michigan, Seward played in every ensemble, winning the prestigious annual Concerto Competition.

Steve Seward is currently the Kansas City Symphony solo tuba and teaches at Missouri Western College in St. Joseph, Missouri. He made several critically acclaimed recordings in the 1980's which are, unfortunately, unavailable.



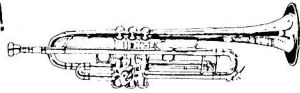

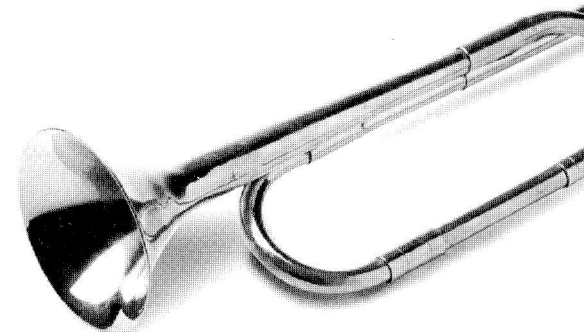
